Dealing With Others

- Don't make assumptions

∞ **10+3=1**

- “I have a problem” not “your stuff is wrong”
- Start off pleasant, THEN escalate
- Admit your mistakes

Don't forget to bribe your SA! (chocolate works)

➤ Pick your battles

- ☞ BCHR (Buffer Cache Hit Ratio) vs. wait events
- ☞ RAID5 vs. "disk is cheap" (BAARF!)

Five.

➤ Know when to compromise

- ☞ Normalization
- ☞ Indexing/Optimization

➤ Do unto others

➤ Be willing to say "I don't know but I'll find out"



Managing Others

- Praise in public, critique in private
- Mentor the team members
- Learn to let go: Delegate!
- Publicize the team's work

- Work with people to set deadlines
- Communicate as much information as you can
- Keep an open door
- Train your replacement

The Ongoing Process

➤ Keep records

- ☞ Problems and solutions
- ☞ Special procedures
- ☞ Exceptions

➤ Learn the business and the application

➤ Learn to teach

- Always keep learning: commit to 1 new skill a year
- Mentor yourself

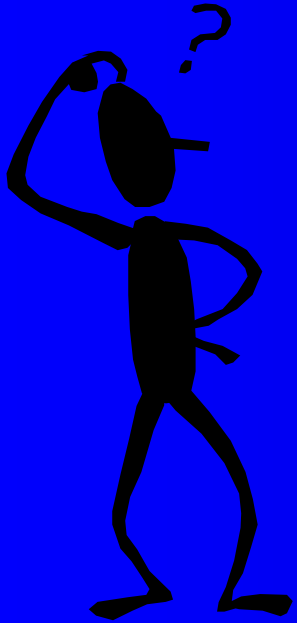
