


- Founded in 1984 for the exchange of ideas, assistance and support among users of Oracle software products.



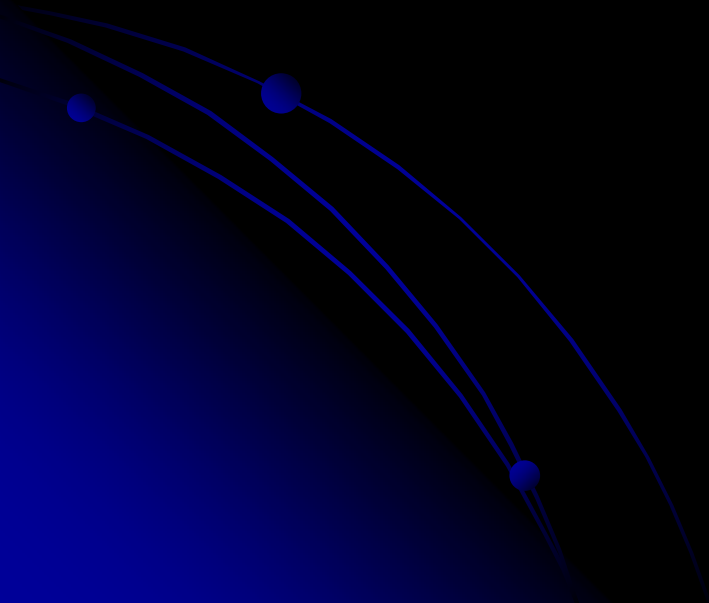
